

## Let's "Give It Up" For the LORD"

Psalm 29

1 Ascribe to the LORD, O mighty ones,  
ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.

2 Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name;  
worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness.

3 The voice of the LORD is over the waters;  
the God of glory thunders,  
the LORD thunders over the mighty waters.

4 The voice of the LORD is powerful;  
the voice of the LORD is majestic.

5 The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars;  
the LORD breaks in pieces the cedars of Lebanon.

6 He makes Lebanon skip like a calf,  
Sirion like a young wild ox.

7 The voice of the LORD strikes  
with flashes of lightning.

8 The voice of the LORD shakes the desert;  
the LORD shakes the Desert of Kadesh.

9 The voice of the LORD twists the oaks  
and strips the forests bare.  
And in his temple all cry, "Glory!"

10 The LORD sits enthroned over the flood;  
the LORD is enthroned as King forever.

11 The LORD gives strength to his people;  
the LORD blesses his people with peace. NIV

Before you answer these questions: READ Psalm 29 several times & take some time to MEDITATE on it. THEN, using the Psalm, answer the questions.

This Psalm has three sections. I have given each section a title or outline heading. Give each section a title of your own.

Vs. 1 & 2 Lift Up Your Voice for Our Majestic LORD

Vs. 2-9 The LORD's Thunderous Voice Is Lifted Up

Vs. 10-11 The Almighty LORD Lifts Us Up

We speak of "giving people their due", or "giving credit where credit is due". We are certainly to do this for the LORD of all people. In vs. 1 & 2 we see "Ascribe" repeated how many times?

Who is to ascribe / give credit or glory to the LORD?  
How are they described?

What are some ways we can or should ascribe proper glory, praise to the LORD?

What are some reasons given as to why do we do this?  
In vs. 3-9 we see "the voice of the LORD" repeated \_\_\_\_\_ times.  
Any ideas what His voice might be in this Psalm?

What seems be described in this section of this poem / song (note the weather terms)?

What all can and does His powerful voice do and / or cause?

In vs. 10, 11 we see four things about the LORD, things He is or does.  
Our awesome, almighty LORD (who was described in vs. 3-9) is or does:

A The LORD

B The LORD

C The LORD

D The LORD

In light of the LORD's greatness (vs. 3-9) and His graciousness (vs. 10-11), reread vs. 1 & 2.

What additional things would you now ascribe to the LORD, credit to Him, praise Him for in light of Psalm 29?

Take time to pray and worship our almighty, awesome God.
